RULES FOR HORSES IN ACTION

1. All Riders must be members of **Coonalpyn & District A. & H. Society Inc.**
Membership is \$20.00 and includes a guest gate entry ticket.
2. Entry Fees: Day Fee of \$20.00 plus membership (pre-entry) entitles rider to compete in Rings, 1 & 2 or 3 plus novelties and show jumping. Royal Qualifying Rings- Additional horses with same exhibitor- \$5.00 per horse.
3. Stockman's Challenge: Membership fee and Pre-entry \$20- entitles competitors to also compete in show jumping events, hacking and novelties if desired.
4. All entries after Wed 18th October including show day include a \$5.00 late fee, OR see front page for entries on the day**

5. All horses must be PIC registered and PIC must be supplied with entries.
6. All exhibits must be ready to enter the ring when requested by Stewards.
7. The Judges & Committee reserve the right to remove any exhibit from the ring or grounds that is considered to be behaving in a dangerous manner.
8. All horses must be nominated by bonafide owner, and where entries are in partnership correct initials must be given on entry.
9. Any person guilty of improper practice will be liable to disqualification.
10. Judge's decision is final.
11. All riders must wear approved helmets, **ASNZ3838** or **ARB HS2012**, and correct riding boots.
12. Persons competing in any event to do so at their own risk.
13. Protests to be in the hands of Secretary 10 mins. after event accompanied with the fee of \$10, which will be forfeited if protest is not upheld.
14. The committee reserves the right to cancel or alter any event on the program
15. Dogs to kept on a leash or tied up at all times- away from horse & cattle areas
16. Ages as stated in the competition will be taken as at the day of Show
17. Horses competing in affiliated rings are expected to hold either a SHC or EA Height Certificate.
18. Horses to be shown as a Hack or a Hunter- not both. Please state on entry form.
19. Rings 1 & 2 are affiliated with the Agricultural Societies Council of SA and therefore are Royal Qualifying events.
20. Once any exhibit has won first prize in two Royal Qualifying events they are not permitted to compete in any further qualifying events in the spirit of fair play but can continue to show in non-qualifying classes.
21. Riders in Rings 1 & 2 may not compete in Ring 3 (Encourage) with the exception of Pony/Riding Club events. Riders must be a member of a Pony Club or Riding Club to compete in Club Events and uniform must be worn.
22. Stallions will not be allowed to compete in harness or hack classes, but can compete in jumping events and Stockman's Challenge.
23. Wrist bands for all Competitors will be available for collection ringside on show morning before competition commences and must be worn.
24. The whip cracking section of the Stockman's Challenge will be run following the completion of Rings 1, 2 & 3.
25. Camping & use of yards is available free of charge, however ALL Competitors are asked to leave yards and float parking area free of rubbish and manure is to be placed under trees. Shower facilities are available at Coonalpyn Caravan Park for a small fee. Please note there are no ATM facilities available on the showgrounds.

A trophy will be awarded to the exhibitor gaining the highest aggregate number of points in at least two (2) Southern Country Shows during 2017.

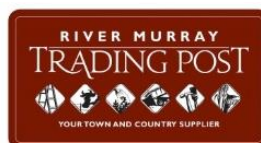

RULES FOR SECTION B- STOCKMAN'S CHALLENGE

1. All entrants must be members of Coonalpyn & District A. & H. Society Inc.
2. All horses must be PIC registered.
3. Pre entry is required by Wednesday 18th October 2017. All entries after this time (including show day) will incur a \$5 late fee, or see front page of this document**. No cash out facilities are available at the show grounds.
4. Open Stockman's (Riders not eligible for the Encourage) 2. Encourage Stockman's Challenge (Riders not eligible for the Open) 3. Junior Stockman's Challenge (Riders 10 years and under 18 years) Three classes in each Challenge: DRY PATTERN, OBSTACLE COURSE & WHIPCRACKING
5. Competitors must be experienced and accomplished riders with appropriately trained and fit horses capable of undertaking the conditions in each or all 3 phases of the event.
6. Competitors may enter more than one horse, but must enter all horses in the same level of competition. If entries are exceedingly high, a restriction may apply. Each additional horse will be charged the full entry fee.
7. A rider may compete on more than one horse. No other competitor may ride the same horse during the competition in the same or any other level.
8. Riders competing in the Junior Section must be at least 10 or more years – but not more than 18 years on the day of the competition.
9. Competitors choosing to enter the Encourage Section are not eligible for the Open & vice versa. Entries in this section will be at the discretion of the committee.
10. The expected dress code must be worn for the entire program and will be comprised of: • Collared shirt with sleeves (jacket and tie for Dry Pattern optional) • Approved safety helmet and footwear must be worn for all events • Moleskins, jeans or jodhpurs will be accepted.
11. All riders must wear approved helmets, **ASNZ3838** or **ARB HS2012**, and correct riding boots.
12. The rider of any horse considered to be acting in a dangerous manner will be warned by the committee in the first instance and then be disqualified if it continues to act in a dangerous manner.
13. Stallions must be ridden and handled by an adult (over 18 yrs) and tied up with both halter and neck strap (double tied).
14. Snaffle bits only to be used – no curb chains.
15. Horses must wear a bit, no bosals or halters will be allowed.
16. No head checks, tie downs, martingales, running reins, nose bands or riding whips will be allowed.
17. The same saddle must be used for the entire three sections of the event, leg protection for horses and spurs at rider's discretion.
18. Competitors must complete the program as set by the committee.
19. No alcohol to be consumed whilst competing or prior to completion of the day's events.
20. No unrestrained dogs allowed.
21. All competitors enter at their own risk with no responsibility accepted by the organizing committee for riders, livestock or property.
22. All decisions made by the judge are final.
23. Any protests must be in writing, lodged within 15 minutes of the completion of the event, addressed to the section convenor and accompanied by a fee of \$50, which will be forfeited if the protest is deemed frivolous.
24. Entries will not be accepted with-out completion of entry forms, waivers and payment; and must include PIC #
